FAQ

- **What do we do with minors?**
 - Make protecting them a high priority
 - For certified house churches, we’re not separating kids at this point
 - Other house churches, we recommend you not separate, but if you do, make sure to have at least two trustworthy adults present
- **How will offerings be received?**
 - For everyone’s protection, NO CASH will be collected in house churches
 - All giving will be electronically given or mailed to Solid Lives
 - For certified house churches, a Text-to-Give “keyword” will be given each house church leader to share with its attendees
 - For not-yet-certified house churches, you can text “SLCHURCH” to 77977
 - Instructions will be given during services and are included at the bottom of these notes.
- **Can Solid Lives House Churches speak other languages?**
 - YES, and we will endeavor to provide a coach who speaks your language

1. BE READY

A. Pre-Service Checklist

- Send out invitations with specific day and time
- Pray for the invitees, the service and yourself
- Prepare snacks/drinks
- Double-check audio/visual
- Clean and set up
- Consider the “five senses” (sight, sound, smell, taste, touch)
- Pray again

B. Order of service

- Warmly welcome guests with love and a big smile
- Remind people what time service is scheduled to begin
- Identify the snacks and the restroom
- Help people engage in wholesome pre-service conversation
- Graciously help people to be seated for service to begin
- Briefly welcome participation and open with a short prayer
- Start the Service Video (comfortably model participation)
- When service is over, help people to process what they heard in a comfortable way
- Make sure each person knows how glad you are that they came

2. BELIEVE

A. Remember, you are not working alone... God is your partner

Joshua 1:9 (NKJV) Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

B. Walk by faith and not by sight

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV) For we walk by faith, not by sight.

C. The word of God is powerful

Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV) So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

3. BE GRACIOUS

- A. **Speak gracious words – Colossians 4:6 (NKJV)** Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.
- B. **Be a peacemaker – Proverbs 15:1 (NKJV)** A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.
- C. **Love never fails – 1 Corinthians 13:8 (NKJV)** Love never fails...

4. BE HAPPY

Philippians 4:4 (NKJV) Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!

5. BE FUN

Proverbs 17:22 (NKJV) A merry heart does good, like medicine, But a broken spirit dries the bones.

6. BE REAL

2 Corinthians 2:17 (NKJV) For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ.

7. BE FRIEND

1 Corinthians 9:19–22 (NKJV) For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more; **20** and to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews; to those who are under the law, as under the law, that I might win those who are under the law; ... **22** I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some.
